This course will use digital photography to help students learn and apply the basic elements of art and the principles of design. Content will include, but is not limited to, the basic mechanics of a camera, compositional foundations, and evaluating a successful photograph. Additionally, students will study different photographers and learn from their styles and strengths to implement on their own photos. This course will also provide students with opportunities to extend their knowledge and skills in the field of photography and the use of Adobe Photoshop and Lightroom. This is an exploratory, hands-on, practical high school class.

Supplies:

- Online resources, apps, and projects will be utilized throughout the semester so access to a computer/internet is required.
- Students will need to bring an iPhone or Android cell phone that has a camera to class for hands-on learning. *They should not bring a separate camera.*
- Note-taking materials such as notebook/binder and writing utensils.
