

Tuition Prices and Policies 2024-25

Annual Tuition for full-time* students

One student enrolled full time in the Tutorial \$2400 per year (\$240/mo)
Two children enrolled full time in the Tutorial \$4300 per year (\$430/mo)
Three children enrolled full time in the Tutorial \$5800 per year (\$580/mo)
Four or more children enrolled full time in the Tutorial \$6900 per year (\$690/mo)

Secondary Tuition for part-time* students

Individual annual class \$600 per year Individual semester class \$300 per year

Elementary and Secondary Tuition Policies

Elementary students (PreK-6th grades) must enroll for classes on both Tuesdays and Thursdays. Secondary students (7th -12th grades) may enroll in the classes that best fit their educational plan.

Student absences, family vacations, and unexpected days that the Tutorial might be closed due to inclement weather or similar scenarios, are not deducted from tuition. To budget and simplify tuition costs per month, annual tuition due will be billed at an average monthly rate beginning in August and ending in May.

Monthly invoice reminders will be emailed directly to you at the beginning of each month. Tuition will then be due by the 15th of each month.

Those wishing to pay tuition by semester may do so; however, there is no discount for prepayment. If tuition is unpaid by the 25th of the month, a \$25 late fee will be automatically charged to your account. If any unpaid balance is 60 days old, you will be asked to withdraw your child(ren) until the balance is paid, including ongoing monthly tuition. The returned check fee is \$25.

^{*}These prices include the multiple child discount when all children are enrolled as full-time students. An elementary student (PreK-6th grade) is considered full time and must attend both days. A secondary student (7th-12th grade) is considered full time when they attend two classes per day all year.

^{*}A secondary student (7th-12th grade) has the option of choosing individual classes. However, the multiple child discount will not be applied.
